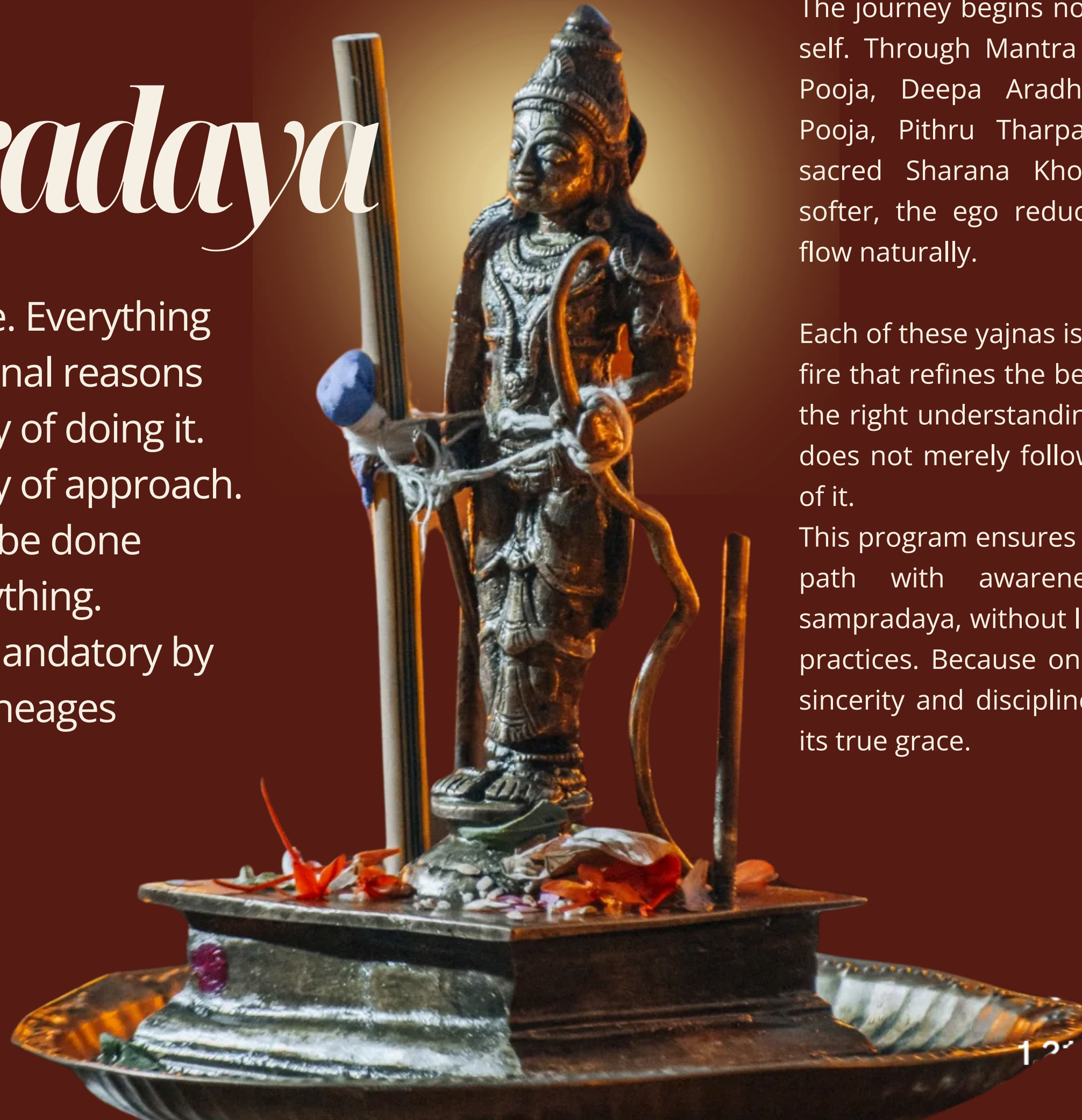

how we do

The Sabarimala Theerdha Yatra is not completed simply by reaching the sannidhanam. It is completed through the proper Sampradaya Vidhi, where every devotee takes part in the mandatory rituals, offerings, poojas, darshans, and spiritual practices that form the true path of the yatra.

Bhajanas, Bhagavad Pooja, Deepa Aradhana, Anna Dhanam, Gurudakshina, Pitru Tarpanam, Tirtha Snanam, Deva Sannidhi Darshanam, Sharana Khosham, Gurudakshina, Parivaaraseva, sacred offerings, and temple rituals are all an important part of the yatra and are considered mandatory for a devotee to participate in.

At the sannidhanam also, there is a proper traditional order to complete the yatra through opening the Irumudi, Neyyabhishekam, darshan, Malikappuram darshan, pradakshinam, prayers, and final offerings.

This is considered the true and proper way of completing the Sabarimala Yatra.

Our program is created to preserve this sacred Sampradaya by conducting all these tantric, spiritual, and devotional rituals under the guidance of Guruswamis, allowing devotees to experience the yatra in its authentic traditional form.

Day 1

Morning darshan at Poornathrayeesa Temple
Darshan at Chottanikkara Bhagavathy Temple
Journey to the Bhajana Mandapam destination and hotel check in.
Village temple darshan and offerings.
Bhagavad Pooja, Naivedyam, Deepa Aradhana, Sampradaya Sharana Khosham, Sampradaya Bhajana, and Anna Dhanam.
Spiritual preparation sessions for devotees.
Rest at hotel.

Day 2

Early morning Bhagavad Pooja, Sampradayika Tantric Pooja, Deepa Aradhana, Devata Avahanam, and Upadevata Avahanam.
Naivedyam and Deeparadhana.
Kettunira ceremony in strict Sampradayika Vidhi.
Gurudakshina, Pitru Dakshina, Mantra Diksha, Yatra Diksha, and Irumudi Kettu by Guruswamis.
Journey to Sabarimala.
Darshans in several temples en-route
Arrival at Erumeli for Petta Thullal and darshan at Petta Sree Dharmasastha Temple, Puthanveedu, and Vavar Palli.
Arrival at Pampa River for Pampa Snanam, Pampa Vilakku ritual, and Pitru Tarpanam.
Journey to Sannidhanam
Darshan, offerings, Abhishekam, and completion of the Sampradaya Vidhi of the Sabarimala Teertha Yatra.



Day 3

Uralkuzhi theerdha snanam
Completion of Darshana Vidhi and Yatra Vidhi at Sabarimala sannidanam and malikappuram Temple.
Return journey.

Darshan at Ettumanoor Mahadeva Temple.
Return to the Bhajana Sthanam.

Kettirakku ceremony.
Rest at hotel.

Day 4

Breakfast.

Prasadam preparation and Prasadam Kit distribution ceremony.

Farewell Sadya.

Airport transfer and departure.



As part of the program, every devotee will receive a specially prepared Prasada Kit packed in a traditional Brahma marandra bag after the completion of the yatra.

The kit will include sacred prasadam collected from the Sabarimala pilgrimage, including one Aravana Payasam, Abhisheka ghee, Panjamritham, Pamba Ganapathi Modakam, and Aval Prasadam from Hanuman Swami at Pamba.

Along with these, our team will carefully prepare and pack a combined Sabarimala Yatra Prasadam made from the sacred offerings received during the pilgrimage.

The kit will also include Manjal Prasadam, Kunkuma Prasadam, Bhasmam, and prasadam received from the Bhajana, Bhagavad Pooja, and other rituals conducted during the yatra.

All prasadam will be carefully prepared and packed by our team on the night of return to the Kettunira Sthanam, allowing every devotee to take home the blessings, sacred energy, and memories of the pilgrimage.
